Saturday June 21st promises to be an exciting and interesting day by the Rivah! Starting at the top of Prince Street, visitors can browse the **Arts**, **Antiques** & Crafts booths, stop for a bite or two at The Tastes of Tappahannock, make their way to the **Beer Garden** and main music entertainment stage then towards the Rivah through the Marine displays.




