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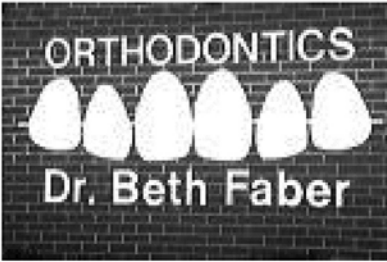
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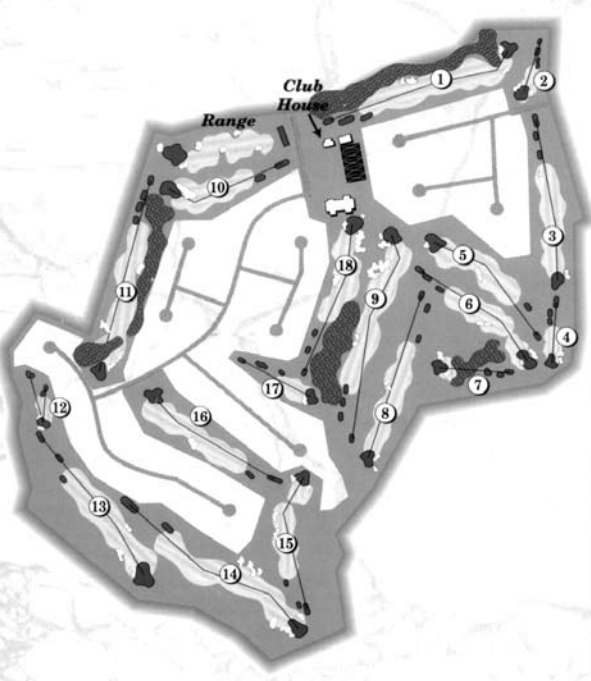



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Da Vinci Code \$500 Tappahannock Treasure Trail

The first prize is a new truck worth over \$30,000 offered by Chandler Chevrolet. The winners of the first round will be invited to perform a shoot out at 5 pm. All participants pay \$1 per ball to play in the Hole-in-One challenge. There are discounts for multiple ball purchases. 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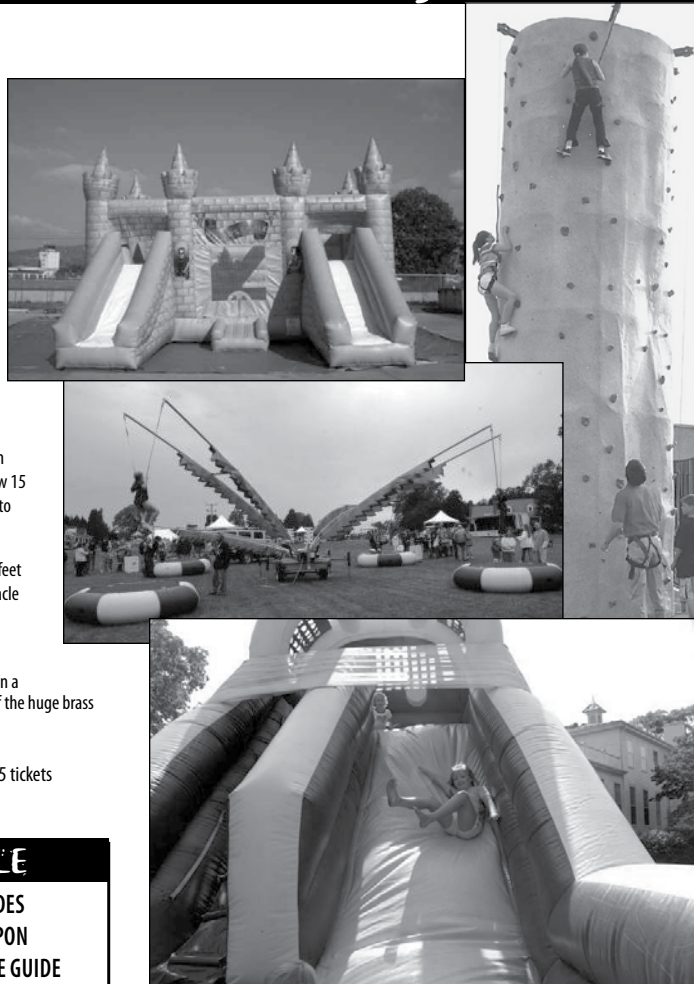
